WILLIAM WOODS UNIVERSITY (WWU), Fulton, MO is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) of the North Central Association. The business and accounting programs are accredited by the Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP). Both agencies are recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA).

INTERNATIONAL AMERICAN UNIVERSITY (IAU), Los Angeles, CA was established in 2005 and is a member of the Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools (TRACS) having been awarded Candidate Status as a Category IV institution by the TRACS Accreditation Commission. TRACS is recognized by the United States Department of Education, the Council for Higher Education Accreditation and the International Network for Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education (INQAAHE).

This purpose of this agreement is to affirm that WWU accepts IAU international student graduates into Master's degree programs following standard university guidelines of an earned Bachelor's degree with a cumulative 2.5 GPA or higher, a TOEFL score of 61 or higher, and any additional admissions requirements of the program to which the student is applying.
