#### NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE DEGREE PROGRAM STUDENTS

This institution is approved by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education to offer degree programs. To continue to offer degree programs, this institution must meet the following requirements:

- Become institutionally accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education, with the scope of the accreditation covering at least one degree program.
- Achieve accreditation candidacy or pre-accreditation, as defined in regulations, by July 1, 2017, and full accreditation by July 1, 2020.

If this institution stops pursuing accreditation, it must:

- Stop all enrollment in its degree programs, and
- Provide a teach-out to finish the educational program or provide a refund.

An institution that fails to comply with accreditation requirements by the required dates shall have its approval to offer degree programs automatically suspended.

## Year-Round Admissions

Applications for admission are accepted throughout the year. There are six (6) enrollment terms per calendar year.

## Accelerated, 2-Month Course Format

IAU condenses its courses into a two-month course format so that a typical semester-long course can be completed in just 8 weeks.

IAU offers morning, afternoon, & evening classes on the weekdays and morning & afternoon classes on Saturdays for the convenience of working students. IAU offers both campus classes and 100% online classes.

## Online Courses Available

The Student Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) allows F-1 students to take one 3-unit online class to meet full-time enrollment. This allows F-1 students to be enrolled full-time, as required by SEVP, while also minimizing their physical commute to IAU.

F-1 students must comply with SEVP regulations.



## Fun Activities & Exemplary Student Service

Each student receives attentive student service by IAU's friendly staff. Admissions advising, academic advising, F-1 student advising, and year-round student activities are all available to students.

IAU holds social activities for students to participate. These include bowling, movie night, and karaoke nights. Holiday parties are also held, for example, St. Patrick's Day, Student Thanx-mas, and Halloween.

## Professional Development Workshops, Internships, Career Services

**JOB BOARD.** A web job board is updated monthly to advertise employment opportunities by local employers. Many of these employers hire IAU's current F-1 students.

**PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOPS.** IAU delivers professional development workshops throughout the year. Learn from our experienced professionals on how to acclimate to the American work culture, streamline your resume, and interview better.

**INTERNSHIPS.** IAU also offers four types of internships to gain different experiences while in school. They include the *IAU Internship*, *SCORE Internship*, *TAP Internship*, and the *CPT Internship*.

**LEGAL WORK AUTHORIZATION FOR F-1 STUDENTS.** Curricular Practical Training (CPT) internships are available to students while studying. IAU grants elective credit for CPT internships units.

Optional Practical Training (OPT) is also available for graduates. At the time of graduation, students can stay in the U.S. legally and work for an additional 12 months.
