



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
YUIN UNIVERSITY
AND
INTERNATIONAL AMERICAN UNIVERSITY



YUIN University (YUIN), Compton, CA was established in 1981 and is Approved by the State of California Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (BPPE) to operate as a degree-granting institution of higher education; is a candidate school with the Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools (TRACS), and certified by Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) under the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to enroll non-immigrant F-1 students for academic programs.

International American University, Los Angeles was established in 2005 and is Approved by the State of California BPPE to operate as a degree-granting institution of higher education and has been certified since 2009 by the SEVP under the U.S. DHS to enroll non-immigrant F-1 students for academic programs.

This purpose of this agreement is to attest that YUIN accepts IAU's Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) and Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree graduates as sufficient to meet the educational requirements for entry into YUIN's MBA and Doctor of Philosophy in Business Administration (PhD) program, respectively. Further, YUIN accepts IAU's courses as transfer credit, as permitted by YUIN's transfer credit policy.

Likewise, IAU accepts YUIN Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration (BABA) and MBA degrees graduates as sufficient to meet the educational requirements for entry into IAU's MBA and Doctor of Business Administration (DBA) program, respectively. Additionally, IAU accepts ay YUIN's courses as transfer credit, as permitted by IAU's transfer credit policy.

Effective May 10, 2018 until written notice is given by both parties to terminate this articulation agreement.
